

Tsunami means harbor wave. A tsunami is a series of ocean waves caused by an underwater earthquake, landslide, or volcanic eruption. More rarely, a tsunami can be generated by a giant meteor impact with the ocean.

An earthquake occurs when a large area of the Earth's crust suddenly moves. When this happens underwater, big gaps may appear on the ocean floor. When water moves in to fill this gap, a tsunami is born. These waves can reach heights of over 100 ft. About 80% of tsunamis happen within the Pacific Ocean's "Ring of Fire."




